THE SHOW



Wow. You're here. I want to invite you to have a conversation with me. We've both waited such a long time for this and now I just don't know if I can find the words. I'm going to need your help, and I'm going to need you to stay. I want to have a conversation with you. I will need you to pump me up, cuddle me, and tell me your secrets. It's about learning how to speak to each other, being honest, and trusting each other.

This show is a piece of autobiographical performance art which explores the topic of consent, most specifically the topic of sexual consent both in the positive and the negative. This was inspired by my own personal experiences with sexual consent and, experiences without sexual consent. I intend on challenging the audience's preconceptions of the language of consent and how we talk about it, or, how we do not talk about it. This piece confronts the notions of sexual consent in a distinctive friendly way; I welcome an audience into this difficult and complicated idea. Not looking to shock or aggressively confront the topic but aiming to explain and reach a greater understanding within the audience.



ABOUT ME

I create autobiographical performances, installations, performances about shared identity, and artistic documentations of work. My main artistic intention is my focus on getting audiences into theatres by making pieces which are accessible and relatable. My work's main inspiration is taboo subjects such as mental health, grief, and consent, although I also experiment with telling stories of the mundane in a simple and playful style.

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


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
